How To Use This Resource



Stories of The Kingdom




Stories are powerful. Whether from a book, in a movie, or memories shared between friends and family, stories can make us laugh, cry, and they can help us to understand more about ourselves and the world we live in.

Jesus would often tell short stories called parables when he was speaking to people. These parables would be used by Jesus to teach about a particular aspect of God and his kingdom, inviting and challenging his listeners to think more deeply about their lives. Jesus' parables have a lot to teach us today as well! 'Stories of the Kingdom' is an 8-week resource designed for you to explore some of Jesus' most interesting parables.

Who Do You Say I Am?



"I am. . ." How we finish this statement about ourselves can reveal a lot about who we think we are.

Jesus used these simple words to declare amazing truths about himself, his purpose and his love for all people. Although Jesus' "I AM" statements sometimes left people scratching their heads, they remain a powerful invitation for us to explore who he truly is and how he demonstrated these truths in word and action!

'Who do you say I AM?' is an 8-week resource based on the "I AM" statements of Jesus. Designed to help your group think more deeply about who Jesus is, students will explore these famous scriptures and discover who Jesus can be for them in their lives today!



Conversations with Jesus



There can be no doubt that the Bible has had a massive impact on the world we live in. Not only is the Bible the highest-selling book of all time, but countless numbers of people throughout history have also believed it contains the very words of God — the God who created all things, including you and me. So, have you ever wondered what the Bible is actually about? Is it just an old book that is now outdated and irrelevant? What does it tell us about God and about the world? How do I fit into this story, if at all? Does God have something to say to me?

These eight studies aim to help you answer all of these questions. 

Memory Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:17



Game: Find the Bible Verse the Fastest

Two teams. Teams are given a verse and they have to find it in the Bible as fast as possible. Then one person (everyone gets a turn) writes the verse on the whiteboard. Whichever team is quickest through all selected verses wins.

Prayer:

Jesus, we thank you that you are the way to heaven, and you died and rose again so we can live with you forever. May we be changed by this truth and live differently because of what you have done for us. Amen.



Each student is given a celebrity and may ask the audience one 'Yes' or 'No' question at a time to guess their celebrity. Students continue to ask questions until they have correctly identified the celebrity. The first participant to correctly identify the name of their celebrity wins. Continue until everyone has guessed their identity. (You can use bible characters!)

Prayer:

God, thank you for giving us faith in you and your Son Jesus. Thank you that you have made us your friends because of Jesus. Please give us more faith so we can trust you more. Amen.



Everyone gets a piece of paper. Write a prayer request. Fold and pass to the left. Keep doing this. After 5 goes, each person reads the points and prays privately.



Activity: Read Psalm 51 before activity. Write up confessions/saying sorry to God for sinning and wipe off with rubber when done.



Hand Signs Confession (Moke a fisst) We are sorry for the times we have got angry with other people. (Point away from yourself with your index finger. We are sorry for the times we have blamed others and seen things wrong in others without recognising how much is also wrong in us. (Close up your hand and hold it close to your chest) We are sorry for the times we have kept things selfishly to ourselves and not been prepared to give to those who need our help. (Put your hand over your mouth) We are sorry for the foolish words we have spoken which have hurt other people. (Put your hand over your eyes) We are sorry for the times we have edilberately chosen not to see the good things we could have done to help other people. (Put your hand over one ear) We are sorry for the times we have not listened to the cries of those who are poor or who suffer injustice. After a pause ask everyone to hold out their hands open palms facing upward, as if they are waiting to receive something. Use words such as: Leader: Jesus said, if you are tired from carrying heavy burdens, come to me and I will give you rest. So we bring all our sins and our failure to love to Jesus. To remember that it is through the cross that our sins are forgiven, everyone traces the shape of a cross with an index finger across the palm of the other hand they are holding out. Leader: Thank you Jesus that you died for us so that we can start a new life in the power of your Holy Spirit. Amen.



Week 1 - Two Builders





This week's activity: Build a Tower

Items needed:

Paddle pop sticks. 3 rolls of sticky tape <u>Procedure:</u>

Small groups of 3 or 4. 10 paddle pop sticks and 1 roll of tape in each group. Aim to make the tallest and most stable tower in the decided time. The tallest standing tower wins.

Week 2 - The Two Sons





This week's activity: Pigs in The Pen


- Use masking tape 2 outline a box on the floor that'll act as the pigs' pen.
- Choose one player to be the pig keeper and the others to act like pigs, crawling on the ground and oinking!
- Once the game begins the pigs can all escape from the pen and hide. The
 pig keeper needs to run around and try to make eye contact with each one
 of the pigs and say their name.
- If this happens, the pig has been caught and they must return back to the pen and stay in there for the duration of the game.
- The aim of the game is for the pig keeper to get all the pigs back into the pen. When the leader decides the game is over, the winner is any pig still loose or the pig keeper if they have all the pigs back in the pen.

This week's Prayer Activity: Father Focus

Focus on the the fact we pray to our "Father" as in the story and remind them of his character

Week 3 - The Good Samaritan





This week's activity: Injured Relay

Items needed:

Between 5 and 10 bandages

Procedure:

Split the SUPA club in half. Ask the groups to nominate one person from their group to be the 'injured friend'. Ask the 'injured friend' to sit down at one end of the classroom. Give each of their teammates a bandage as they line up on the other side of the classroom. Relay race each person

until the injured friend is fully wrapped.

This week's Prayer Activity:


Write a list of people we know to be outsiders or in need (sick etc). Then write next to them how we can help them. Pray for them and ask God to give us courage and his heart towards the suffering people.

This week's memory verse: Luke 10:36-37

"Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?" The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him." Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise."

Week 4 - The Hidden Treasure and the Valuable Pearl





Game: The Price is Right

• Items needed: A packet of cookies or Iollies

Bring a packet of cookies or lollies along to SUPA club. Ask the students to take turns guessing the cost of the item and respond with higher, lower or correct! Once the value is guessed, share the item with the group.



Draw a treasure chest on a whiteboard. Write up inside characteristics or roles, stories, events of Jesus' life and person inside, showing his worth. Make them into praise points.



Memory Verse: Matthew 13:44

"The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field."

Week 5 - One Sheep





Game: The Lost Chocolate

Items needed:

- A block of chocolate
 - 1. Hide a block of chocolate (or something else they can share) somewhere in the room.
 - 2. Give the students a couple of minutes to find it, encouraging them to search harder by using a timer.
 - 3. When found, celebrate by eating it together.

Prayer: For Lost Sheep

Prayers for lost sheep we know (those not following Jesus). Ask God to remind us that we are also lost without Jesus and so to encourage us to listen to him and obey him.



Memory Verse: Luke 15:7

Jesus said, "In the same way there is more happiness in heaven because of one sinner who turns to God than over 99 good people who don't need to."

Week 6- The Great Banquet





Game: Party Time

Items needed:

- Party decorations (balloons, party hats etc.)
- Party food

Prepare a special party for your students. Maybe you could set up a nice table with food and decorations or blow up some balloons and play a fun party game. Either way, just make sure it's something different from your normal SUPA club and has the feeling of a special party.



Prayer: Party Prayer

Write prayers on serviettes or other decorations from the party. Open prayer. Thank God for his goodness.

Memory Verse: Luke 14:15

After Jesus had finished speaking, one of the guests said, "The greatest blessing of all is to be at the banquet in God's kingdom!"

Party Week

Take this week as an opportunity for students to invite their friends to lunchtime group. Feel free to organise a pizza lunch and run fun games to engage all the new kids. Game: Rob The Nest

Items needed: Balls and/or small bean bags

- Divide the students up into 3 teams and ask them to stand in opposite corners or in a triangle shape.
- Pick a few items (balls and small bean bags would work well) and put all the items in the middle.
- Give a signal to start the game.
- The first person from each team runs up and grabs an item from the middle and adds it to their teams' nest.
- Teams can also steal from other teams until time runs out.

Prayer: Sharing Prayers

Make commitments to sharing our things, time, money, etc.
Gratitude prayers because thankfulness is key to valuing what we've been given.

Week 10 - Prayer

What is Prayer?

This week we further explore what prayer is and why we pray. Use the idea card below to promote discussion and lead your bible talk.



Activity: Chinese Whispers

Students form circle, and the first player whispers this weeks bible verse (1 Peter 5:7) to the ear of the second person. The second player repeats the verse to the third player, and so on. When the last player is reached, they announce the verse they heard to the entire group. The first person then compares the original message with the final version.

Prayer Activity - Silent Prayer

Sit in a circle and play some instrumental worship music. Have the leader open in prayer and for 1 minute allow the students to sit and pray silently. After one minute the leader can then close in prayer.

Memory Verse: 1 Peter 5:7

Term 4 Plan WHO DO YOU SAY I AM?



Week 1 - The Light for the World





Game: Hidden Keys

Choose one student to sit on a chair and ask the other students to form a circle on the floor around them. Ask the student on the chair to close their eyes, and place a set of keys on the floor beneath them. Choose one student from the circle to retrieve the keys and return to their spot without being tagged. The student on the chair must keep their eyes closed and can only use their hands to try and tag the student as they take the keys. If the student trying to take the keys gets tagged, they become the new person on the chair.

Prayer: Light Up Prayer

Bring a torch/phone torch. Turn lights off and pass the torch around the circle. The Person with light prays. Pass it on.



Memory Verse: John 8:12

"Once again Jesus spoke to the people.

This time he said, "I am the light for the world! Follow me, and you won't be walking in the dark. You will have the light that gives life."

Week 2 - The Good Shepherd





Game: Animal Jumble

Give each student a piece of paper and a pencil then place them in groups of 4 or 5. Ask each student to draw a different body part of an animal of their choice (e.g. fish tail, elephant trunk, chicken body). Ask each group to put their funny animal together with sticky tape and share what they have called their animal (e.g. fish-ele-ken!).

Prayer: Pin the Prayer on the Sheep

Make or draw a sheep and have the students write prayer points on paper. Pin it on sheep and pray for the prayer requests as a group.



Memory Verse: John 8:12

"Once again Jesus spoke to the people.

Week 3 - The Bread That Gives Life





Game: Food True or False

Ask all the students to stand in the middle of the room and call one side of the room 'true' and the other side 'false'. Read out the following food related statements. Each student chooses either true or false and moves to that side of the room. Give the correct answer and then move on to the next statement.

- Hot Cross Buns are usually eaten at Christmas: False
- French Fries were invented in France: True
- Australia is the largest producer of bananas: False
- Bees produce vegemite: False
- McDonald's has restaurants in over 100 countries around the world: True

Prayer: Bread Prayer

Bring bread loaf. Students pray for something new each time they eat a piece of bread.

Memory Verse: John 6:35

"Jesus replied: I am the bread that gives life! No one who comes to me will ever be hungry. No one who has faith in me will ever be thirsty."

Week 4 - The Gate





Game: The cat, the mouse and the gate


Pick two students to be the cat and the mouse. The other students form a circle and hold hands, becoming a gate. The mouse stands inside the circle and the cat stands outside. The aim of the game is for the mouse to get outside the circle and avoid being caught by the cat. The mouse cannot stay inside the circle for more than 10 seconds. The cat cannot come into the circle but they can reach into the circle to tip the mouse. The students have to try and keep the cat away from the mouse by holding up their hands to let the mouse in and out of the circle. If the mouse is caught, they become the new cat. The old cat joins the circle and another student becomes the new mouse.

Prayer: Waterfall Prayer

Everyone prays out loud all at once until it sounds like a crowd of mixed prayers and voices.

Memory Verse: John 10:9

I am the gate. All who come in through me will be saved. Through me they will come and go and find pasture.



Week 5 - The Way, the Truth, and the Life






Game: Knots

Ask the students to form a small circle, standing shoulder to shoulder. The students close their eyes, reach out their arms and grab hold of the hand of two different people from across the circle (excluding the person on either side). Once they are all holding two hands, students open their eyes and work together to find the way to untangle the knot without letting go of the hands they are holding. The game stops when the students have found the way to untie themselves and have formed a new circle.

Prayer: Through Jesus

Leader asks if any one has any prayer requests. Start prayer by saying "Dear Jesus" and close the prayer by saying "in Jesus name amen" to emphasise that Jesus is the Gate to God.



Memory Verse: John 14:6

"I am the way, the truth, and the life!" Jesus answered. "Without me, no one can go to the Father."

Week б - The Vine






Game: Fruit Salad

Form a circle with chairs that has one chair fewer than the total number of students. Nominate a student to be "in" and ask them to stand in the centre of the circle. Go around the circle and give each student a fruit name, either apple, orange or pear. The student who is "in", calls out one of the fruits. If they call out "apples", everyone who is that fruit must get up and change seats. The student who is "in" also tries to sit in an empty spot, leaving one person without a chair. The student not sitting in a chair is then "in".

Prayer: Prayer Link

Students sit in a circle and hold hands. The leader starts off in prayer and squeezes the person next in the circle for them to pray. Continue around the circle until every one has prayed.



Memory Verse: John 15:5

I am the vine, and you are the branches. If you stay joined to me, and I stay joined to you, then you will produce lots of fruit. But you cannot do anything without me.

Week 7 - The One Who Raises the Dead to Life





Game: Guess the action

- Ask I student to stand at the front of the room with their back to the group.
- Ask the other students to act out 1 of these actions; 'alive' (hands raised in the air), 'asleep' (both hands together like a pillow beside their head) and 'faith' (both hands covering their heart).
- Ask the students to 'freeze' in the action they chose.
- Then ask the student at the front to turn around while doing one of the actions. Any student who is doing the same action is out.

Prayer: Prayer Jar

Students write down their prayer requests on paper and put it in the jar. Then leader prays for all prayer points.

Memory Verse: John 11:25

Jesus then said, "I am the one who raises the dead to life! Everyone who has faith in me will live, even if they die."





Week 8 - Who Do You Say I Am





Game: Who am !?


Give each student a piece of paper and ask them to answer the following questions:

- What is your favourite animal?
- What is your favourite sport?
- What year are you in?
- What is your last name?

Collect all the answer sheets and choose one to read out to the group. Giving one of the answers at a time, students put up their hand if they think they know who the student is. Continue until someone answers correctly and then go on to the next answer sheet.

Prayer: Prayer Bookmarks

Hand out paper cut in rectangular book marks and allow students to decorate them and write a prayer point on it. This way, whenever they use the book mark they are reminded to pray for it.









- Depending on your numbers and on time you can make this maze as simple or complicated as you like.


Prayer: Birthday Prayer Wall

Week 2 - Faith During an Emergency

Game: Who's in the Crowd?

- Have everyone stand together in a group.
 Nominate one person to be the 'guesser' and have them step out and face away from the group.
- Then quietly nominate another person to be the 'speaker'.
- The speaker's job is to say, "I'm in the crowd" in a voice that the guesser won't recognise.
- Once they have said their line, ask the 'guesser' to turn around and guess who the speaker was. If they get it right, they get another turn. If they are wrong, the 'speaker' becomes the new 'guesser'.

Prayer: North, South, East, West

- Ask the group to face each of these directions in turn and then pray together in silence, or out loud, for any specific needs, personal, individual, local, national, global in that direction.
- Find out where the missionaries from your church, or those you support, are working and pray for them as you face the direction of their mission field... Bring a compass to the meeting!

Memory Verse: Mark 5:30

At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked, "Who touched my clothes?"








Week 3 - Faith That Brings Healing

Game: What's in the Bag?

- Gather some objects that are soft, smooth, rough, bumpy, etc. and put them into a paper bag.
- Explain to the group that they are going to play a game to test their sense of touch.
 Without looking inside, someone from the group reaches into the bag and holds one of the objects.
- Then they must tell the group what they think it is and then take it out of the bag to see if they were right. You can play as many rounds as there are objects.



This is a prayer with a challenge! Set an egg timer for a minute or two, then pray for one particular person. See how many different blessings you can pray over that person before the egg timer beeps.



Memory Verse: Mark 5:31

"You see the people crowding against you," his disciples answered, "and yet you can ask, 'Who touched me?' "



Week 4 - Faith That God is Good



Game: Squeeze Chain

- Ask the group to stand in a circle and hold hands.
- Choose one person to start the squeeze chain by squeezing the hand of the person on their left or right. The squeeze then gets passed around the circle.
- After the squeeze has passed around the whole circle, you can make the game harder by reversing the direction of the squeeze by squeezing twice quickly.

Prayer: Prayer Ball

Like silent ball, but you pray every time you catch the ball.

Memory Verse: Mark 5:34

He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."



Week 5 - Faith in God's Timing



Game: A Race Against Time

- Today's game is a race against the clock to try and complete a task.
- Set one minute on a timer and ask one person to try to pull out all the tissues from one tissue box before the timer ends.
- Then set the timer again and ask someone else to try to put all the tissues back in the box before the timer ends.

Prayer: Skittles Prayer

Open the packet of Skittles/Starbursts and take it in turns to pick one. Before eating the sweet, a prayer is said asking God to help or do something for someone or something in the category below or come up with your own:

Red: family / Purple: friends / Green: school / Yellow: you / Orange: world

Memory Verse: Mark 5:36

Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, "Don't be afraid; just believe."





Week б - Faith Instead of Worry

Game: 4 Corners

- Name the four corners of the room, 1 to 4.
- Pick one person to be 'in' and have them stand in the middle of the room.
- Once they close their eyes, everyone else travels from one corner to any other corner they like.
- After everyone has made it to their corner, ask the person who is 'in' to pick a corner number before opening their eyes. Anyone standing at the corner they pick is out.
- You then continue to play until there is only one person left travelling around the corners.

Allows each person to share how they are going and pray accordingly. A great way to build a closer community within your lunchtime group.





Memory Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:17 NLT



Part 1: Conversations with Jesus



Week 1 - Jesus and Bartimaeus



Game: Use Your Senses!

- Bring to SUPA club some items that have a unique sound, smell or shape (e.g. an apple, stuffed toy, rattle, etc.) and place them in a bag.
- Take turns placing a blindfold on each student as they select an item from the bag and ask them what they think it is, then ask them how they reached that conclusion.

Prayer: Close beside us


- Actions and prayer.
- "Jesus is before us preparing the way (point forwards). Behind us (point backwards) helping us come what may. Beside us here with us today (point to the side). Always with us every hour of every day (point down)."

Week 2 - Jesus and Peter



Game: Keep Your Eyes on the Ball!

- Bring a soft ball to SUPA club that can be thrown around the room.

- Thank god every time you open a layer.



Term 4 Plan The One Behind the Book



Week 1 - Creation: The Perfect Start



Game: 52 Card Pick Up

- Spread pack of cards on floor.
- Wrap five students in duct/masking tape.
- Let kids roll around and "stick" up the most cards.
- Assign each card a Bible verse and ask students to read aloud the verses that match their cards.

Prayer: Graffiti Wall

- Put up a big sheet of paper horizontally on a wall.
- 2. Write prayers.
- 3. Walk along the wall to view and say prayers.

Game: Twisted List Game

- Split into 2 teams and choose a runner.
- Create several lists from Bible facts (3 parables of Jesus, books of the OT...)
- The twist is that some of these lists will include an item (or 2) that don't fit.
- Goal: runner identifies the outlier, says their name, and says the answer.

Prayer: Popcorn Prayer


Open prayer, with people popping in whenever and praying. Use specific prayer requests or random.

Week 4 - The Prophets; Clues about the Christ



Game: Coin Connections

- Get enough coins before your meeting for each student, making sure there are no "antique" coins (i.e., the years before your students were born).
- Each student gets a coin and takes a turn sharing how old they were and something significant that happened to them the year the coin was minted.

Prayer: Salvation Bracelet

- Make a bracelet with red, white, blue, green, white, black, yellow beads.
- Explain through the photo to the right.
- Or make a book with the colours.

Memory Verse: Isaiah 7:14

But the Lord will still give you proof. A virgin is pregnant; she will have a son and will name him Immanuel.



Week 5 - God With Us; Jesus Shows the Way



Game: Encouragement Shower

 Pick a different person each week (or several people if your group is small) and have the other members of the group shower them with encouragement, positive qualities they notice about the person or something they admire.

Prayer: Song


Sing a psalm or a song which is a prayer to God (Our Father - Hillsong Worship)

Prayer: Waterfall Prayer


Everyone prays aloud at the same time. Then you clap at the end!

Game: Life-Size Tic Tac Toe


- 1. Arrange three rows of three chairs (so that there is a square of nine chairs total).
