Why gifts in Wills are crucial



Important things to know

WE URGE YOU TO LOOK AFTER YOUR LOVED ONES FIRST

First and foremost, we want you to make sure you have taken care of your family and friends in your Will. After doing this, you might like to help future generations of young people hear about Jesus by contributing a gift in your Will.



EVERY BEQUEST HAS AN IMPACT

No matter the size of your gift, remembering Scripture Union NSW in your Will helps us continue our ministries to reach children, young people, and families in practical and meaningful ways. Smaller gifts are combined to fund our work well into the future and larger gifts can have the potential to establish a new program or service.

There are three types of gifts you can choose from:

A RESIDUARY BEQUEST

After taking care of family and friends, you can leave all or a percentage of the remainder of your estate to Scripture Union NSW.

A PERCENTAGE OF YOUR ESTATE

Leave a nominated portion or fixed percentage of your estate to Scripture Union NSW. This will remain inflation-proof and you'll be less likely to need to update your Will in the future.

A SPECIFIC BEQUEST

Leave a specific sum of money or a specified item, such as artwork, jewellery, property, antiques or shares, to Scripture Union NSW.



Our promise to you

- We appreciate that your Will is very personal to you. We will always respect your privacy and treat your information confidentially. However, once admitted to probate, a Will is generally a publicly accessible document.
- We recognise it's your decision to leave a gift in your Will and you need to decide in your own time.
- We would love to know if you have left a gift in your Will to Scripture Union NSW, but we understand if you would prefer not to tell us.
- If you do choose to tell us, we will give you the choice about how you would like your gift acknowledged and how we talk to you in the future about our work.
- We will use your gift carefully and cost effectively so that it has the greatest impact.

- We will honour your legacy gift with care, sensitivity, and respect.
