- Self-reflective



Capability Group 3 : Work Skills

Specific aspects:

- Demonstrated capability in financial management and fundraising (in a not-for-profit setting desirable)
- An appreciation for the role of technology in ministry and business settings
- Strategic planning
- Compliance management
- Highly organised
- Ability to work with all necessary stakeholders (Including the Scripture Union NSW Board)



Capability Group 4 : Interpersonal Skills

Specific aspects:

- Able to lead, care for, manage and develop a diverse group of people
- Develop and articulate direction and purpose
- Capacity to build an effective leadership team
- Clear and consistent communicator
- Willingness to listen to and respond to stakeholder concerns
- Able to implement change effectively



Capability Group 5 : Commitment to Scripture Union Ethos and Mission

- Promote the interdenominational nature of Scripture Union working in partnership with churches
