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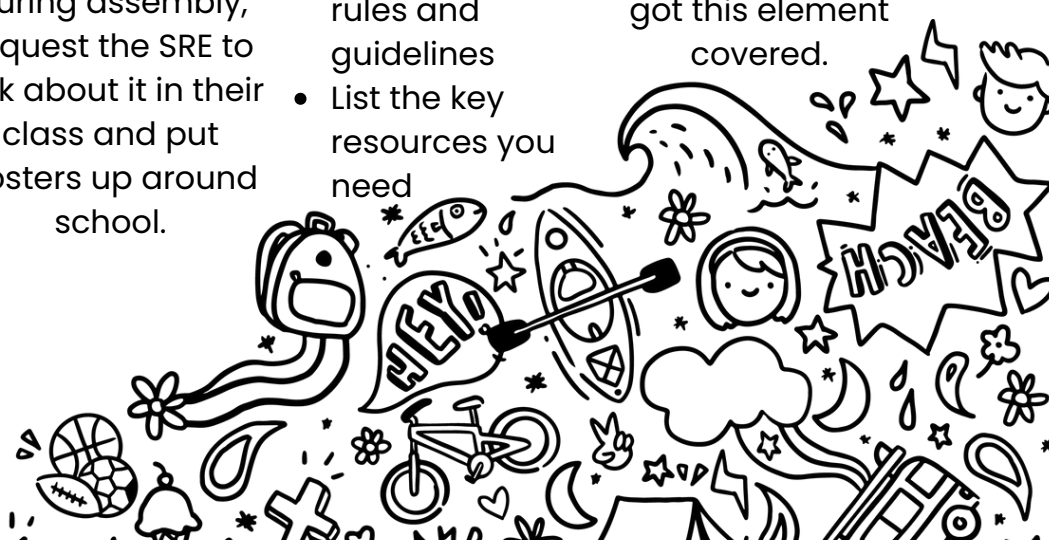

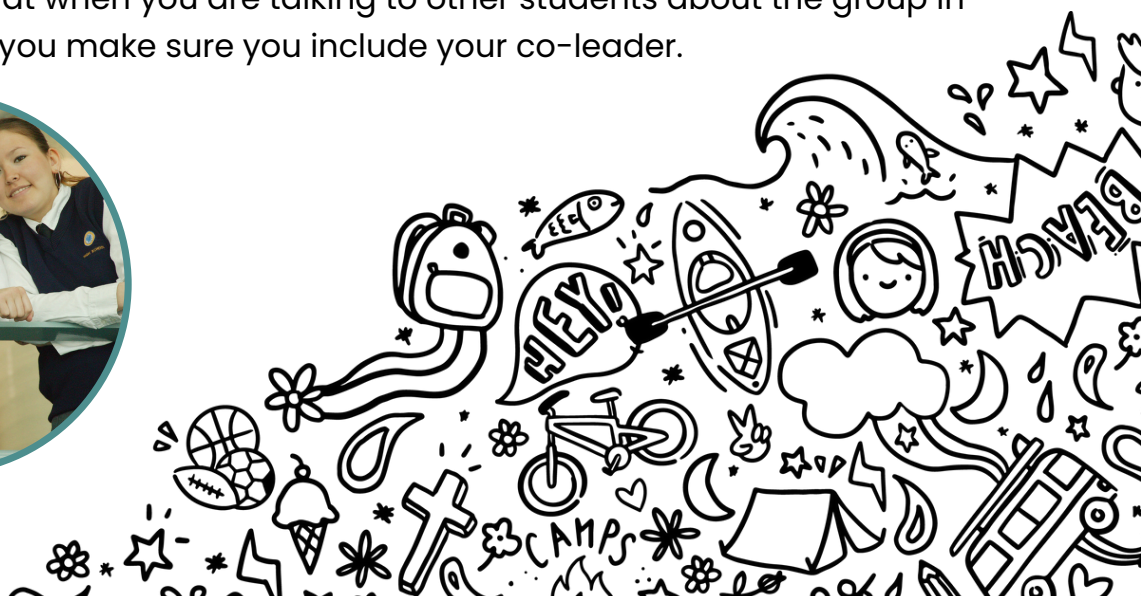
- **Be Responsible:** Being a leader gives you power—use it wisely and never misuse it.

- **Grow Your Faith:** While helping others, also focus on your own spiritual journey. Remember, Jesus is with you, so talk to Him and follow His teachings.
- **Ask for Help:** Know when to reach out for support for yourself or others. It's super important if someone shares they've been hurt by adults.
- **Be Accountable:** Take responsibility for your actions and stick to your commitments with your group and leaders.
